Key Features Include:


- Military-grade Deployable Rapid Assembly Shelter (DRASH) withstands extreme weather and temperature conditions.

- "Turn key" system can be integrated with heating, cooling and power generation to form a complete infrastructure solution.



Basic Package:

The Mobile Vaccination System basic package includes the following components:

- 442 square-foot DRASH MX Shelter System with integrated doors, screen windows, ECU ports and utility ports, ground tarp, fabric floor, transport bag, repair kit, push poles, wind lines and a steel pin stake set.
- Small bladder and blower system.
- DRASH 4-Light Set with wiring.

Optional Features:

Additional optional features can also be included with the system to enhance operational capability including:

- Mobile power generation and HVAC unit ensure that system can be independent of external power, heating or cooling sources.
- Hardened flooring allows for ease of set up and post emergency clean up.
- Medical equipment storage bags hang from the wall of the shelter to provide easy access to supplies.
