

The 25-Bed Medical Surge Facility basic package includes the following components:

- Three (3) MX5 Center Sections and two (2) MX end caps
- Integrated doors, screen windows, ECU ports and utility ports, ground tarps, fabric floors, transport bags, repair kits, push poles, wind lines and steel pin stake sets
- Fabric air plenum system
- Two (2) 5-Ton Mobile ECUs
- Three (3) DRASH 4-Light Sets

Optional Features:

Additional optional features can also be included with the system to enhance operational capability including:

* Genset, cots and furniture (as shown) are optional. For information about additional accessories, please contact the DHS Systems representative for your area.

- Small bladder and blower system ensures **no heavy lifting** when putting up or taking down the shelter.
- Hardened flooring allows for ease of set up and post emergency clean up.
- Cots and furniture can be provided for a complete "turn key" system.
- Mobile power generation and distribution ensures that system can be independent of external power sources.
